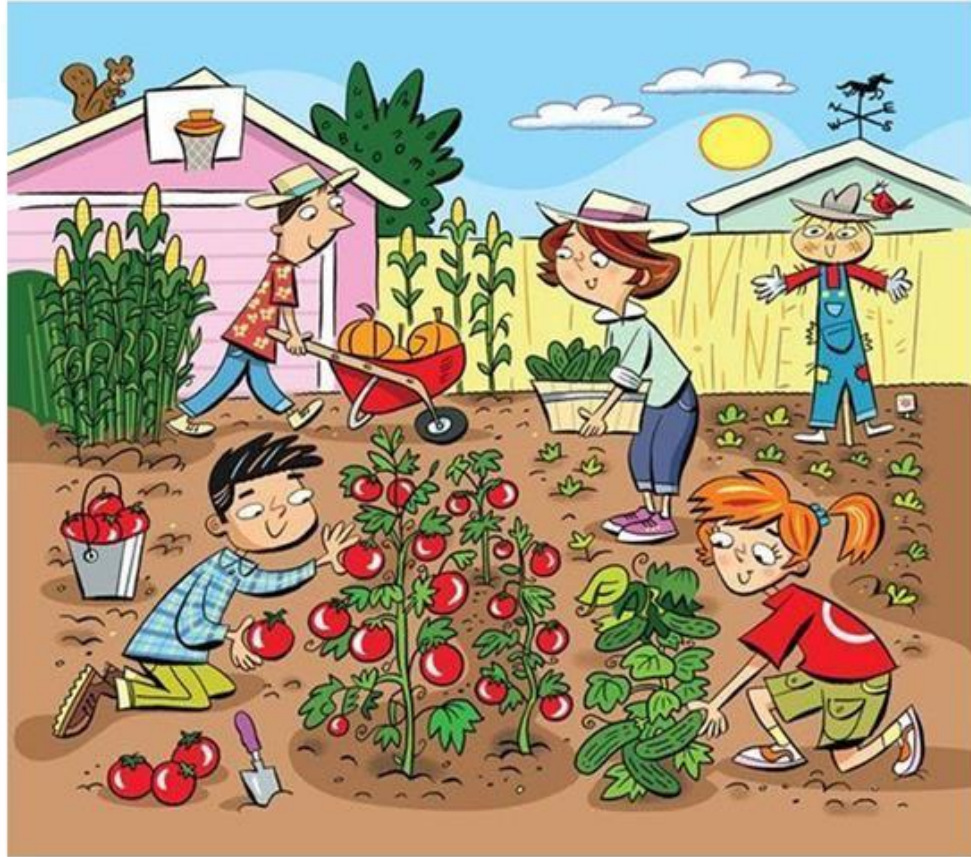

**Examples**  
*I like chocolate.*  
*They like the zoo.*  
*We like vegetables.*



**Remember!**  
 Add an 's' for she, he and it.  
*She likes apples.*  
*He likes the park.*  
*It likes warm water.*

**Be careful!**  
 For negatives add 'don't' or 'doesn't'.  
*I **don't like** chocolate.*  
*He **doesn't like** the zoo.*  
*They **don't like** vegetables.*
